

YOU COULD BE A LIFE SAVER

Organ donation law has changed to help save more lives.

The organ donation system has become an opt-out system. 'Dáithí's Law' means that in the event that organ donation is a possibility after you die, unless you choose to opt out, or are in an excluded group*, you will be considered as a potential organ donor.

Organ donation is a personal decision and you still have a choice if you wish to donate or not.

If you do not want to become an organ donor then you need to opt out on the NHS Organ Donor Register. You can do this at any time.

You should continue to record your decision on the NHS Organ Donor Register. Whatever you decide, please remember to talk to those close to you to help them support your decision at a difficult time.
